PRIVACY POLICY

Welcome to use our Orange Connex Fulfilment Management Platform (“**this Platform**”) as well as the sites, services, applications and tools available through this Platform (collectively “**Services**”), this Privacy Policy describes the basis on which your personal data will be processed by us in the process of your access and use of this Platform and Services.

Please note that depending on the country/region where you are located while using this Platform and Services, there may be certain country/region specific terms that may apply to you that form an integral part of this Privacy Policy.

1. Scope and Update of this Privacy Policy

- 3.1 This Privacy Policy applies to your access and use of this Platform and Services provided by us (the applicable entity disclosed in section 2), regardless of how you access or use these Services, including access via our sites, applications, and portals.
- 3.2 This Privacy Policy also applies if express reference is made to it by means of a link or in a similar manner, such as our Terms of Use.
- 3.3 We may change this Privacy Policy at any time by publishing the amended version on this Platform and stating the effective date of the amended version. When we update this Privacy Policy, we will take appropriate measures to inform you, consistent with the significance of the changes we make and as required by applicable law, such as by posting an amended Privacy Policy on this Platform and/or by email.

2. Controller

3. Data Protection Officer and Contact

- 3.1 In those countries where we are legally obliged to do so, we have appointed data protection officers to monitor the protection of your personal data. 4. What Personal Data We Collect and Process

We collect your personal data when you access and use this Platform and Services, create a user account, provide us with information via a web and/or portal form, add or update information about your account, participate in community discussions or in any other way contact us. We also collect personal information from other sources (such as our Affiliates, partners and a third-party service provider).

Overall, we collect the following personal data:

4.1 Personal data that you provide when you are accessing and using this Platform and Services or when setting up an account

- (a) Data that identifies you, including but not limited to name, address, telephone numbers or email addresses, your username, country/region, identification card number or passport number, validity of identification card or passport, tax identification numbers (e.g., VAT/GST/UTR number) and eBay ID, which you provide when opening a user account or at a later date as well as other identification data and tax identification numbers, which you provide to us for use of this Platform and Services;
- (b) Information about underlying transactions (such as sales and delivery of goods) that you provide to us during your use of this Platform and Services, including but not limited to contact name, zip code, email, contact address and bills;
- (c) Financial information (including but not limited to credit card and account numbers, payment data) you provide to us during your use of this Platform and Services;
- (d) Shipping, invoice and other data that you provide for the warehousing and delivery of an item, as well as information that is required for processing (including but not limited to tax numbers or other identification numbers, if applicable) and relevant shipping information (including but not limited to tracking numbers and tracking);
- (e) You can provide us with more information through a web and/or portal form, by participating in community discussions, member chats, inquiries, dispute resolution, or by calling our customer service representative, or if you contact us for other reasons regarding our Services;
- (f) Other data that we are legally obliged or authorized to collect and process and that we need for your authentication, identification or for checking the data we collect, for the purpose of detecting, preventing, curbing and investigating fraudulent, money laundering and other security incidents.

4.2 Personal data that we automatically collect when you are accessing and using this Platform and Services or when setting up an account

- (a) Data that arises in the context of your underlying transactions on e-commerce platforms/websites (listing, sales, inventory, secondary sales) that is linked to your

- account as a result of an order you placed on this Platform, such as ordering number, Stock Keeping Unit (SKU) information, time and place of the order;
- (b) Data that our service providers collect on our behalf from you for the purposes of Services, such as SKU inbound receipt, dispatch and return information, tracking numbers, tracking events, inventory quantity, weight, dimension, storage conditions and other inhouse status etc.), and shipping options;
 - (c) Data about your interaction with this Platform, including statistical information about your usage of the platform, your settings for advertisements, and your communication with us;
 - (d) Computer and connection information, information about traffic to and from websites, referral URL, information about your interaction with advertisements, your IP address, your access times, type and version of your browser, your device's operating system, and your language settings.

4.3 Personal data that we collect in connection with the use of cookies and similar technologies

We use cookies, web beacons and similar technologies to collect data when you use this Platform and Services. We collect this data from the end devices (including mobile devices) that you use to use this Platform and Services:

- (a) visited pages, the time, frequency and duration of the visits, the links you click on and other actions that you take as part of your use of our services and in advertising and email content;
- (b) Data about your activities and interactions with our advertising partners, including information about which ads have been shown to you, how often they have been shown, when and where they have been shown and whether you have performed an action, such as clicking on an ad or making a purchase;
- (c) Model or device type, operating system and version, type and settings of the browser, device ID or individual device identifier, ID for advertisements, individual device token, and data relating to cookies (e.g., cookie ID);

For more information about our use of these technologies and your choices, see the section on Cookies and Similar Technologies below (section 5).

4.4 Personal data from other sources

We also collect personal data about you from other sources and from third parties:

Data from public sources (e.g., demographic data).

We combine the data you provide with data from these other sources. If third parties provide us with personal data, we take measures to ensure that the personal data were collected with your consent and/or that these third parties are otherwise entitled to disclose your personal data to us. We also have access to personal information about you from our Affiliates.

5. Cookies and Similar Technologies

When you use our Services, we and selected third parties can use cookies and similar technologies to offer you a better, faster and safer user experience or to show you personalized advertising. Cookies are small text files that your browser automatically creates and that are stored on your device when you use this Platform and Services. Our cookies and similar technologies have the following different functions:

- (a) They are technically necessary for the provision of our services;
- (b) They help us to technically optimize this Platform and Services (e.g., monitoring of loading times);
- (c) They help us to improve your user experience (e.g., saving the font size and entered form data);
- (d) They enable us to show you more relevant advertisements.

5.1 We use cookies and similar technologies that are only stored on your device for as long as your browser is active (session cookies), as well as cookies and similar technologies that are stored on your device for longer (permanent cookies). We take appropriate security measures

to prevent unauthorized access to our cookies and similar technologies. A unique ID ensures that only we and/or selected third parties have access to cookie data.

5.2 Cookies which are not technically necessary in order to provide the Services, such as functional cookies offering advanced usability, statistical cookies tracking the use of the website and services and marketing cookies used to analyse behaviour and personalise content, will only be used if you provide us with your express consent.

5.3 Additionally, you are free to deactivate the use of cookies and similar technologies in the settings of your browser and/or device. You can also decide whether we can use cookies and similar technologies to show you personalized advertisements.

5.4 If you decide against us processing your personal data for advertising purposes using cookies (and similar technologies), this does not mean that you will not be shown any advertisements. It simply means that these advertisements are not personalized for you using first-party or third-party cookies, web beacons or similar technologies. As a result, you will no longer receive personalized advertising in the future, but personal data can still be recorded, as described in this Privacy Policy. We do not allow third parties without your consent to track or collect your personal data on this Platform for our own purposes.

6. Purposes and Categories of Recipients

We process your personal data for different purposes. We primarily process your personal data to provide and improve our Services, to provide you with a personalized user experience on this Platform, to contact you about your account and our Services, to provide customer service to you, and to detect, prevent, curb and investigate fraudulent or illegal activity. We also pass on your data to third parties for these purposes. Below you will find a summary of the purposes for which we process your personal data, including the categories of recipients to which we transmit personal data for the purposes stated:

6.1 We process your personal data in order to fulfil the contract concluded with you and to provide Services to you. This includes the following purposes:

- (a) Provision of our Services, provision and improvement of functions such as payment processing, evaluations and account management, and ensuring the functionality of our Services. As part of the provision of our Services, we send messages in connection with your access and use of this Platform and Services according to your notification settings in your account;
- (b) Enabling the delivery of the items by warehouse, delivery and other logistics service providers (such as overseas warehousing, Last Mile Delivery), including notifications in connection with the delivery (such as information on shipment tracking), the latter insofar as this is permitted without your consent;
- (c) Providing our payment services (such as recharge online, repayment, invoice issuance/ management/ sending, bills review etc.);
- (d) Clarifying problems with your account, settling disputes and providing other customer service and enforcing fee claims. For these purposes, we can contact you by notification on this Platform, by email, phone, SMS, push notification on your mobile device or by mail. If we contact you by phone, to ensure efficiency, we may use automatically dialled calls with announcements or automated text messages;
- (e) Enforcement of our General Terms and Conditions, the Terms of Use, and other principles;
- (f) Publication and promotion of your ordering and the corresponding content on this Platform or in the applications, services and tools of our Affiliates or cooperating external operators of websites, applications, services and tools.

If necessary, we transmit your personal data to processors and the following other recipients for one or more of the purposes mentioned:

- (a) Other users;

- (b) Our Affiliates: [Orange Connex Global Group Limited, Orange Connex Global Germany GmbH, Orange Connex Global UK Limited, Orange Connex Global AU PTY LTD, ORANGE CONNEX GLOBAL USA INC]
 - (c) Our partners including e-commerce platforms (such as eBay etc.);
 - (d) External service providers and shipping companies (such as UPS, DHL, GLS etc.);
 - (e) Payment service providers (such as Citibank, PayPal, Payoneer etc.);
 - (f) External operators of websites, applications, services and tools.

If we pass on your order information and related personal data to external providers, this will only be done on the basis of an agreement that limits the use of this personal data by the external provider to the purposes that are necessary to fulfil the contractual obligations towards us. The external provider is contractually obliged to take appropriate security measures with regard to this data. External providers are in no way authorized to provide personal data to third parties unless otherwise agreed by you. When transmitted to our Affiliates, such restrictions result from our common binding company rules.

6.2 We process your personal data in order to fulfil our legal obligations. This includes the following purposes:

- (a) Participation in proceedings (including court proceedings) that are carried out by government agencies, in particular to investigate, investigate and prosecute illegal acts;
- (b) Prevention, detection and containment of illegal acts (e.g., fraud, money laundering and terrorist financing);
- (c) Ensuring the information security of this Platform;
- (d) Storage of your personal data to fulfil specific statutory retention requirements (for more information on storage of your data, see Storage Period and Deletion).

If necessary, we transmit your personal data to processors and the following other recipients for one or more of the purposes mentioned:

- (a) To law enforcement agencies, courts, other government agencies, intergovernmental or supranational agencies;
- (b) External service providers;
- (c) Third parties who are involved in legal proceedings if they provide us with a legal order, a court order or an equivalent legal order;
- (d) To credit bureaus, if this is legally mandatory (e.g., information on payment delays, defaults or other irregularities that may be relevant to your credit report);
- (e) Our Affiliates.

6.3 We process your personal data in order to pursue our legitimate interests, provided that your interests or fundamental rights and fundamental freedoms do not prevail. In order to harmonize our interests with your rights, we have introduced appropriate control mechanisms. On this basis, we process your data for the following purposes:

- (a) Participation in proceedings (including legal proceedings) that are carried out by courts, law enforcement authorities or other governmental, intergovernmental or supranational bodies, in particular to investigate, prosecute unlawful acts, unless there is already a legal obligation to do so and we can legitimately assume that the disclosure of the data is necessary to avert impending disadvantages or to report suspected illegal activity. In such cases, we will only disclose the data that we believe to be necessary, such as name, location, postcode, telephone number, email address, IP address and complaints about fraud;
- (b) Protection of legitimate interests of third parties in the context of civil disputes, unless there is already a legal obligation to do so and we can legitimately assume that the data must be passed on to such third parties in order to avert impending disadvantages;
- (c) Prevention, detection, containment and investigation of fraud, security breaches and other prohibited or illegal activities, including the assessment of corresponding risks (e.g. [by using Captchas or using the phone number you have stored in your account as part of a two-factor authentication]), unless there is already a legal obligation to do so;
- (d) Monitoring and improving the information security of this Platform, in each case unless there is already a legal obligation to do so;

- (e) Conducting identity checks, credit checks, evaluating applications and comparing information for verification purposes;
 - (f) Automatic filtering and, if necessary, manual review of messages sent by you on this Platform to protect against fraudulent or suspicious activity or violations of our General Terms and Conditions or our other principles;
 - (g) Analysis and improvement of the use of the Services (if any), for example, by checking information from our users about blocked or crashed pages in order to identify and solve problems, by analysing the aggregated and statistical usage data of the service, and to provide you with an improved user experience;
 - (h) Sending advertising by post (according to your notification settings in your account);
 - (i) As far as this is legally permissible, contacting you by electronic mail (e.g., email) or telephone to offer you vouchers, discounts and special promotions, to conduct opinion surveys to inform you about our Services (according to your notification settings in your account). If you do not want to receive marketing communications from us, you can also unsubscribe via the link in the email you received;
 - (j) Display of notices of special promotions and information about our Services after logging in your account (according to your notification settings in your account);
 - (k) Customize page content based on the actions you take;
 - (l) Providing shared content and Services (such as registering for Services and providing customer service) with our Affiliates or cooperating payment service providers;
 - (m) Initiation, preparation, and execution of a company purchase, e.g., in the case of a merger with another company or a takeover by another company. If such an event should occur, we will require the new merged company to comply with this Privacy Policy regarding your personal data;
 - (n) Exercise or defend against legal claims, including legal claims asserted by one user against another user.

If necessary, we transmit your personal data to processors and the following other recipients for one or more of the purposes mentioned:

- (a) Our Affiliates;
- (b) External service providers;
- (c) To law enforcement agencies, courts or other government agencies, intergovernmental or supranational agencies;
- (d) Third parties involved in legal proceedings;
- (e) Payment service providers including the PayPal Inc. group of companies;
- (f) Credit bureaus (e.g., information on payment delays, defaults or other irregularities that may be relevant to your credit report);
- (g) Other companies as part of a company acquisition.

6.4 With your consent, we process your personal data for the following purposes:

- (a) Verifying your identity before you use this Platform and Services.
- (b) Handling customer service requests to fulfill your requests for this Platform and Services.
- (c) Advertising by telephone or electronic mail (such as email or SMS), including advertising by our Affiliates or by third parties.
- (d) Processing of your address data in order to be able to provide location-related services.
- (e) Processing of your personal data based on consent that you have given so that we or third parties can enable you to use certain additional services or provide them to you;
- (f) In order to create Business Insights to improve our business, the Platform, and the Services, we analyse shipping, logistics and other information connected to your orders and transactions and will combine this information with similar data collected;
- (g) Analysis of telephone calls with our customer service, which we have recorded with your consent;
- (h) Assessment of the quality and success of our email marketing campaigns (e.g. by analyzing opening and click rates);
- (i) For the use of cookies which are not technically necessary on your device (cf. above section 5).

You can withdraw your consent at any time with effect for the future.

6.5 Data Exchange Between Us and Our Affiliates

As set out above under “Personal Data from Other Sources”, we may also receive your personal data from our Affiliates:

- (a) In particular, this allows us to provide you with information about products and services that we believe may be of interest to you, and to improve this Platform and Services, and advertising by analysing your use of the services of other Affiliates, in particular by comparing certain data (e.g., cookie IDs). Your personal data will only be exchanged and processed for these purposes if you have provided consent to us.
- (b) We may also receive personal data of yours from our Affiliates in order to better prevent, detect, contain, and investigate fraud, security breaches, and other prohibited or unlawful acts, and better assess risks. We may also grant our Affiliates for the above purposes access to personal data about you. We do this based on our legitimate interests in preventing fraud and other risks, and because our legitimate interests are not overridden by your interests, rights, and freedoms.
- (c) As described above, with your consent we may also transfer data regarding logistics, transactions, orders to [Orange Connex Global Group Limited] in order to be statistically analysed and create Business Insights. We will use these Business Insights to improve our business, the Platform, and the Services.

You hereby understand and agree that insofar as our Affiliates have access to your personal data, they will take data protection measures that are at least the same level as the measures described in this Privacy Policy.

7. Automated Decision Making

We use technologies that qualify as automated decision making or profiling, especially in order to personalise advertisements and the services we provide to you. We will not make any automated decisions about you that would significantly affect you, unless such a decision is required under a contract with you, we have obtained your consent or we are legally obliged to use such technologies. For information on your right to object, see Rights as a Data Subject below.

8. International Data Transfers

Some of the recipients of your personal data are located outside of your country or have offices in countries where the data protection laws can offer a different level of protection than the laws in your country. We provide appropriate guarantees when transmitting data to such recipients:

8.1 Whenever we transfer personal information to such recipients, we ensure that the information is transferred in accordance with this Privacy Policy and as permitted by the applicable laws on data protection.

8.2 When you register an account, your account information will be transferred to and stored in HK, and/or the following country/region nearest you: UK, Germany, Australia, Italy, the United States. We take appropriate steps to ensure that recipients of your personal information are bound to duties of confidentiality and we implement appropriate measures to ensure your personal information will remain protected in accordance with this Privacy Policy, such as standard contractual clauses.

8.3 Operations and maintenance staff will be in China for maintenance, who will not have access to the data.

9. Storage Duration and Deletion

9.1 Your personal data will be stored by us in accordance with the applicable data protection laws, insofar as and as long as this is necessary for the respective processing purposes mentioned in this Privacy Policy.

9.2 We retain your personal data for the following periods:

- (a) For as long as necessary to provide our services to you:
This includes, the **execution of the Terms of Use with you**, the maintenance and improvement of the performance of our Services, the maintenance of the security of our systems and the maintenance of correct business and financial documents. For instance, during the period upon filling in the registration information and submitting such application for approval on this Platform, to obtaining the approval, your personal data shall be regarded as the initial registration data and stored in [Orange Connex Global Group Limited]. If the application fails to be verified by this Platform, the initial registration data will be stored therein for three months and then deleted. Otherwise, if your application gets verified and approved, then aforesaid registration data shall be transferred to the corresponding country/region in accordance with this Privacy Policy and the applicable laws and regulations, and subsequently, the initial registration data stored in [Orange Connex Global Group Limited] shall be deleted with the exception that your personal data shall be stored therein pursuant to this Privacy Policy.
- (b) For as long as you have provided your consent to us:
If we process personal data on the basis of consent (including consent to extended storage), we store the data for the period that is necessary for the processing of your personal data in accordance with your consent, or until you withdraw your consent.
- (c) For as long as legal, contractual or other similar obligations require us to:
Corresponding retention requirements may arise, for example, from laws or official orders. It may also be necessary to store personal data with a view to pending or future legal disputes. Personal data contained in contracts, communications and business letters may be subject to statutory retention requirements depending on national law. We may store your personal data for a longer period if we are legally obliged to keep your personal data longer (e.g. for tax, accounting and auditing purposes). To the extent permitted or required by law, we restrict the processing of your data instead of deleting.

9.3 When the retention period has ended, we delete your personal data or take measures to properly anonymize the data.

10. Your Rights as a Data Subject

10.1 Subject to possible restrictions under national law, you as the data subject have the right to information, correction, deletion, restriction of processing and transfer of your personal data. You can also withdraw your consent once given and object to our processing based on legitimate interests. You can also lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority.

10.2 Your rights in details:

- (a) You can **withdraw your consent** to the processing of your personal data by us at any time. As a result, we will no longer process your personal data based on your consent in the future. The legality of the processing carried out based on the consent until the revocation is not affected by the revocation. Your affected personal data will then be deleted, unless there is another legal basis for which the data needs to be retained (especially legal retention obligations).
- (b) You can request **information** about your personal data processed by us. In particular, you can obtain information about the processing purposes, the category of personal data, the categories of recipients to whom your data has been or will be disclosed, the planned storage period.
- (c) You can request the immediate **correction** of inaccurate or completion of your personal data stored with us.
- (d) You can request the **deletion** of your personal data stored by us, subject to further requirements.

-
- (e) You can request that the processing of your personal data be **restricted** to specific purposes, for instance, if you refuse to have it deleted and we no longer need the data, but you need it to assert, exercise or defend legal claims need or you have objected to the processing.
 - (f) You have the right to receive your personal data that you have provided to us in a structured, common and machine-readable format and to have us transmit it to another controller ("**right to data portability**").
 - (g) You can complain to a supervisory authority. As a rule, you can contact the supervisory authority of your usual place of residence, your workplace or the seat of the person responsible .

10.3 IF YOUR PERSONAL DATA ARE PROCESSED ON THE BASIS OF LEGITIMATE INTERESTS, YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO OBJECT TO THE PROCESSING OF YOUR PERSONAL DATA, PROVIDED THERE ARE REASONS FOR THIS THAT ARISE FROM YOUR PARTICULAR SITUATION. THIS ALSO APPLIES TO RELATED PROFILING. IF WE PROCESS YOUR PERSONAL DATA FOR DIRECT MARKETING PURPOSES, YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO OBJECT AT ANY TIME TO THE PROCESSING OF YOUR PERSONAL DATA FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUCH ADVERTISING; THIS ALSO APPLIES TO PROFILING INSOFAR AS IT IS CONNECTED TO SUCH DIRECT ADVERTISING.

10.4 You can exercise the foregoing rights through [Global.Fulfillment@orangeconnex.com], in addition, you are of course free to contact us in other ways, especially via the contact details disclosed above.

10.5 If you would like to change your settings regarding our notifications (including marketing communications), you can do so at any time under ["Notification Settings"]. If you do not want to receive marketing communications from us, you can also unsubscribe via the link in the email you received. For information on how to manage your settings regarding cookies and similar technologies, see Cookies and Similar Technologies.

11. Minors' Privacy

This Platform and Services are not intended for the use by minors. We do not knowingly collect personal data from users who are considered minors under applicable national laws. If a minor has provided us with personal information without the consent of a parent or guardian, the parent or guardian should contact us to delete such information.

12. Security Measures

For registered users of this Platform, some of your information can be viewed and edited through your account, which is protected by a password. We recommend that you do not divulge your password to anyone. We have instructed our personnel to never ask you for your password in an unsolicited phone call or in an unsolicited email. If you share a computer with others, you should not choose to save your log-in information (e.g., user ID and password) on that shared computer. Remember to sign out of your account and close your browser window when you have finished your session.

No data transmission over the internet or any wireless network can be guaranteed to be perfectly secure. As a result, while we use appropriate technical and organisational measures to protect the information we hold for you, we cannot guarantee the security of any information you transmit over the internet.

We implement appropriate technical and organisational measures to prevent unauthorized access to this Platform, to maintain data accuracy and to ensure the correct use of the information we hold. Upon becoming aware of a data breach, we will notify you and/or the regulatory authorities in accordance with the timescales and scope required by applicable data protection law.

13. Other Important Information on Data Protection
